



## Swiftwater Sports 2008 Fly Fishing Adventures

Our fly fishing adventures are designed as hands-on learning experiences where everyone pitches in with camp chores and takes turns rowing a river raft. At Swiftwater Sports we rent and sell inflatable riverboats, so these incredibly inexpensive trips help promote our products. Of course you don't have to buy anything, so come along and meet some new people, fish some great rivers, and have a memorable river trip.

### Lower Deschutes River, Oregon..... four-day trip

Oregon's Deschutes River is considered the Pacific Northwest's best trout and steelhead river. No other river around here hosts such an abundant population of resident and sea-run rainbows. Although no one is allowed to fish from a boat, a boat is really the best way to access the prime parts of the Deschutes. Our four-day trips take advantage of the spring salmonfly hatches and late-summer/fall steelhead migration.

All our trips are on the last 24 miles of the river. Here there is no restrictive private property and no roads; the only way to get there is by boat. The lower river is wider, shallower, and much easier to fish. The resident rainbows—known as *redsides*—are less fished and easier to catch. The May trips occur during the salmonfly (giant stonefly) hatch. Fishing on the June trip is also excellent; the weather is warmer in June.

Five to ten-pound summer-run steelhead begin entering the Deschutes in early August. By September and October, the numbers of these large fish are prime. Some of those going on the fall trips target steelhead and fish down through the many steelhead runs in the lower canyon. Others fish for redsides and occasionally have a steelhead take their nymphs and most of the backing from their five or six-weight rigs.

## Methow Weekend Outing

Eastern Washington's Methow River flows into the Columbia north of Lake Chelan. It is far enough away from Seattle to keep casual weekend fishers from visiting it. Because of concerns for the Methow's endangered steelhead, the National Marine Fisheries Service has made the river catch-and-release from June 1 to September 30.

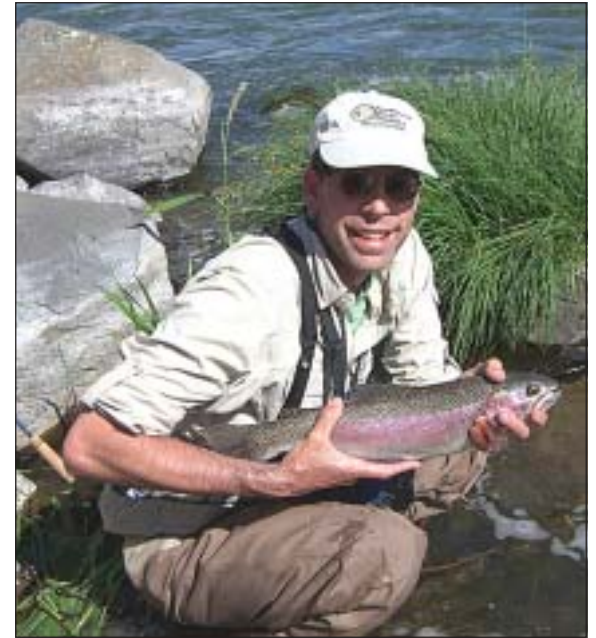

## Reservations & Cancellations

Most trips fill a month or so before they are scheduled. Since cancellations do occur, we have a waiting list for each trip.

A 50% deposit is taken as a reservation; the balance is due before the trip begins. Reservations can be made by mail, phone, or in person. We take Visa and Mastercard.

Your deposit is fully refundable if you cancel your trip 30 days in advance of the trip date. If you cancel within 30 days of the trip, your reservation is forfeited unless we can fill your spot.
